平成29年度本博士課程教育リーディングプログラムに入学させる学生を
下記により募集する。

———— アドミッションポリシー ————

日本とフロンティア・アジア等を拠点とし、博士号取得後、職業人として政財官学界で活躍しグローバル社会を牽引するトップリーダーとなるべき豊かな資質を備えた人材を受入れる。

1 応募資格

次の各号のいずれにも該当し、平成29年4月に本学の博士課程（前期課程）1年に入学した者、ならびに平成29年10月に入学することが決まっている留学生（法学研究科実務法曹養成専攻を除く）

- (1) 名古屋大学大学院博士課程（前期課程）修了後、同博士課程（後期課程）進学を希望する者
- (2) 博士課程（後期課程）修了後、企業、官公庁、国際機関など広く社会で活躍することを希望する者

2 募集人員

募集人員：正規履修生15名程度（日本人学生9名、留学生6名程度を想定＊1）。
準履修生若干名。

3 応募手続

希望者は、とくに所属研究科からの指示がない場合には、所属研究科の学務担当者に、下記応募書類をそろえて平成29年4月28日（金）までに提出する。

4 応募書類

(1) 履歴書（指定様式）

(2) 小論文（A4用紙2枚程度にまとめること、様式不問、日英どちらでもOK）

「課題：フロンティア・アジアで活躍するプロフェッショナルに求められるものは何か」

(3) 指導教員の推薦書（指定様式、厳封の上同封のこと）

(4) 英語を母国語としないものにあつては、英語力に関する客観的な能力証明（IELTS、TOEFL、TOEICのスコア等コピー可）

5 選抜方法

所属研究科において、第一次選考が行なわれる。その結果、PhD登龍門推進室による第二次選考の対象になった者に対して、書類審査及び面接が行なわれる。面接試験は、6月1日～3日を予定している。面接では自身の研究内容を10分、本プログラムでの抱負を5分にまとめて発表する。（プレゼンテーション・ソフト等を使用することが望ましい。）

6 最終合格者発表

登龍門ウェブサイトに掲載する。併せて、合格者には文書で通知する。
本プログラムへの参加手続きに関する詳細については、合格通知時に併せて連絡する。

7 入学料及び授業料

本プログラムへの応募費用や、本プログラム参加のための入学料・授業料の費用は発生しない。ただし、プログラムへの参加により、入学料及び授業料の免除が受けられるわけでないことに留意すること。

8 経済的支援

本プログラム正規履修生は、平成29年10月から月額20万円、準履修生は月額8万5千円の学修奨励金を受け取ることができる。また、住居に関する支援を別途講ずる。

9 その他注意事項

- (1) 応募後、応募書類の変更はこれを認めない。
- (2) PhD登龍門推進室は、必要に応じて応募者から追加で情報の提供を求めることがある。
- (3) プログラムへの参加が許可された後、応募書類に虚偽の記載が含まれることが発覚した場合は、参加許可を取り消す場合がある。
- (4) 個人情報の取り扱いについて；応募にあたって提供された住所・氏名・生年月日その他の個人情報は、選抜、選抜結果の通知、及びプログラムへの参加手続き等、本学における管理運営上必要な手続きを行うためにのみ利用する。また取得した個人情報は適切に管理し、利用目的以外には使用しない。

Guidelines for Admission to International Graduate Studentship under Leading Graduate School
Program (Ph.D. Professional: Gateway to Success in Frontier Asia)
[Academic Year of 2017 (H.29)]

The key theme of “Ph.D. Professional: Gateway to Success in Frontier Asia” is to nurture talents to become leading figures in a variety of fields: business administration and management, government, law, and politics, education and scientific research, mass media and communications, and for-profit or non-profit international organizations and other relevant fields. To raise those “professional Ph.D's”, each candidate will be given lessons, seminars and opportunities for internship in order to gain and finesse abilities to communicate and discuss own ideas, to create and develop a project on one's own, to solve and manage a problem as it arises, and to become a leading work force anywhere in a global market.

This Leading Graduate School Program, “Ph.D. Professional: Gateway to Success in Frontier Asia” (hereafter “the Ph.D. Professional program”), is designed as a set of five-year active learning courses and trainings in addition to regular master's and doctoral curricula provided for earning both degrees in his or her own field of study. The Ph.D. Professional program is open to the first-year (master's level) graduate students at Nagoya University [*1].

*1 As of April 2017, first-year graduate students in the division of Law School are not eligible to apply.

1. Eligibility for Application

Those who meet all of the following qualifications are eligible to apply:

- (1) to be admitted or to be enrolled into a relevant master's program at Nagoya University,
- (2) to be admitted as international student (stated in his or her visa stamp),
- (3) to plan to enter a doctoral program at Nagoya University in order to continue his/her studies upon completion of a master's degree at Nagoya University,
- (4) to have strong desires to work in business, industries, government, or international organizations after completion of the program.

2. Positions Available at Ph.D. Professional Program

15 full-member positions available (including 9 Japanese Graduate Students and 6 international Graduate Students)

A few affiliated-member positions may also be available.

3. Official Application Procedures

Full application packages are accepted by personnel in charge of educational and student affairs at each graduate school (“gakumu” or “kyomu-gakusei-tantou” at “kaku-kenkyuka”) until Friday, April 28th 2017, unless stated otherwise by a graduate school.

4. Official Application Package

Any qualifying applicants should submit the following four materials to be considered as a candidate for the Ph.D. Professional program.

- (1) curriculum vitae,
- (2) short essay: please state in your own words what are the important or required qualities and abilities to be a leading figure to explore and to prosper in any uncharted fields and topics concerning the Frontier Asia [*2],
- (3) recommendation letter from an academic advisor,
- (4) proof for English proficiency (IELTS, TOEFL, or TOEIC scores, etc.) if English is not a candidate's native language. (A copy is available)

*2 For essay, please keep it under two pages in A4 format; be sure to keep word counts under 700.
(Free-form, Either English or Japanese is acceptable)

The forms for 1 and 3 are available upon request or through the web page for the Ph.D. Professional Program. In order to keep confidentiality, please seal the envelope containing the recommendation letter from an advisor.

5. Selection Process

Each candidate will be evaluated based on the application materials by his or her respective graduate school first; and then document screening and an interview will be given by the members of the Ph.D. Professional Office to those candidates who are highly recommended by their graduate schools. At the interview, each candidate is expected to present his or her own research work (or interest to be pursued) in ten minutes and to deliver his or her plans and purposes to achieve by joining this challenging academic program in five minutes (use of presentation softwares permitted and also recommended). Based on each candidate's performance, the prospective students for the program will be selected.

Interviews are to be scheduled for June 1st ~3rd, 2017.

6. Result of the Interview

The result will be notified via the web (<http://www.phdpro.leading.nagoya-u.ac.jp/eng/>); each candidate will also be notified of the result of the interview (and admission procedures to those who would be accepted) via postal mail or e-mail as well.

7. Enrollment Fee and Tuition

Admission to the Ph.D. Professional program does not guarantee any waivers for enrollment fee and tuition at Nagoya University. However, there will be no additional cost for prospective students to participate in the Ph.D. Professional program.

8. Financial Support

The recipients of full-member position will receive an academic scholarship as financial support. The amount of the stipend is 200,000 JPY per month starting in October 2017. Furthermore, housing support / subsidy may be available as well. Affiliated members will receive a stipend of 85,000 JPY per month. [*3]

*3 The scholarship may be renewable annually until the standard term limit for graduation (four academic years and one academic term for those who have enrolled the University in Spring term;

five academic years for those who have enrolled in Fall term). The amount of financial support may also be subject to vary or to termination based on programmatic budgetary restriction.

9. Additional Notes

- (1) No change in any of the document is permitted after submission.
- (2) Applicants may be requested to provide additional information upon request from our admission office.
- (3) If, after admission, it is discovered that any documents have been falsified, admission will be nullified.
- (4) Handling of Private Information: Applicants' personal information such as address, name, date of birth, etc., will be utilized only for the purpose of selection for admission, announcement of results, admission procedures and academic affairs. All personal information submitted is managed properly and shall not be used for any other purpose.
- (5) The Ph.D. Professional program will have a forum to introduce the program itself and its academic curriculum at 17:00 JST on Tuesday, April 11th, 2017 at E&S Hall (E&S Building).
